For ten million points, what is this TV show featuring Bender, Fry, and Leela set in the 31st century.

Answer: **Futurama**

2. **This type of event is credited with one of the earliest and longest running uses of consumer crowdsourcing. In the original advertising, Forest Whitaker asked people to decide between Revolution, Voltage, and Supernova. In the second incarnation of this event, sportscaster Erin Andrews promoted the smooth-citrus White Out over the other two choices of key-lime Distortion and tropical punch Typhoon. Other popular flavors excluded from these events include Baja Blast, Game Fuel, and Code Red. For ten million points, name these online campaigns to choose the flavors of a particular soda product.**

Answer: accept anything related to the **online voting or contest to choose the flavor of Mountain Dew, Dewmocracy, PROMPT on Mountain Dew**

3. **According to experts in sports medicine, this feat is not broken often because of human biomechanics. Although disputed among some statisticians due to wind speed on game day, Aroldis Chapman achieved this feat and broke it by the largest margin recorded. Kerry Wood is the only person to ever do this at Wrigley Field. Nolan Ryan was the first person ever recorded to do this and currently holds a Guinness World Record for doing so. Her favorite foods are Starbucks coffee cake and tuna although she would never admit it. Another caption featuring this figure states, "Good morning? No such thing." Her real name is Tardar Sauce spelled with a d. For ten million points, what is this feline known for its permanently fixed cantankerous facial expression.**

9. This band formed in New York City in 2008 by its three members who had previously been in separate bands including Anathallo and Steel Train. This band has released two albums, the second of which has gone platinum as of January 2013. Their first album, Aim & Ignite was praised by some critics as "the essential pop album of 2009." This band's lead singer was frontman for The Format and its lead guitarist dates the star of HBO's Girls. Their second Some Nights has reached great fame and its most famous track featuring Janelle Monae has been used by Glee, Gossip Girl, The Superbowl, and probably a bunch of children's choirs. For ten million points, name this band which in 2012 composed Some Nights and We Are Young.
