

David Nickel - Housewrite Disaster Fall 2021

Read this aloud to players - This packet is brought to you by David Nickel. The moderator reserves the right to assign power and super power as they see fit.

1. As chronicled in a 1966 book, a character with this surname, along with his partner Dick, went on a spree of cashing fake checks while being chased by the police for the more heinous spree he had just committed in Kansas. In 1973, a tennis player with this surname signed a deal with Adidas - the shoe that came from it originally featured his face but the other surname "Haillet" above it. A man with this surname is the founder of the only correct religion is South Park. For 10 points, give this common surname that the author maintains is the only correct way to answer a "name this person" question you don't actually know the answer to. **Smith**
2. *Name the performance location - description acceptable.* During a 2014 performance of the song "Who Needs You" on one of these platforms, *The Orwells'* lead singer began writhing on the floor. *Foo Fighters* canceled a leg of a South American tour to perform "Everlong" for the last time one of these things aired. Jimmy Vivino headlined a "Basic Cable Band" for one of these platforms. For 10 points, name these shows hosted by the likes of Jack Paar, Conan, and unfortunately, Jimmy Fallon. **Late night talk shows**
3. A famous stairwell in this city lead to a second-floor studio which recorded the likes of Howlin' Wolf, Bo Diddley, and Muddy Waters. That studio was Chess Records. A 2010 album which begins with Nicki Minaj reciting a poem based on Roald Dahl's *Cinderella* begins with its artist "fantasiz[ing] 'bout this" wealth back in this city. That album's red covers were illustrated by George Condo. A rapper whose surname is legally Duckworth's parents left this city for Compton in an attempt to escape its gang violence - that man is better known as Kendrick Lamar. Another artist from this city collaborated with 47 Hats to redesign the logo for one of this city's baseball teams. For 10 points, name this city, home to Kanye West and Chance the Rapper. **Chicago**
4. *Note one word answer required.* This is the first word on the first single released by the Yardbirds after Jeff Beck replaced Eric Clapton. A 2006 song whose name starts with this word begins with the lyrics "No I don't feel better/When I'm fucking around". A band titled for one of these things released a song titled for a fast, aggressive fish on their third studio album, Little Queen. That group is fronted by Ann and Nancy Wilson. For 10 points, name these things who provide the first word to the title of a song which begins "She eyes me like a pisces when I am weak. I've been locked inside your *this shaped box* for weeks". **Heart**
5. A 2006 *Cold War Kids* song titled for one of these people says he's "[O]n death row. He's just waiting for a pardon". A 1971 Leonard Cohen song title for one of these people who received this title 489 years after her flaming death and sings of "No moon to keep her armor bright". This honorific modifies "Elsewhere" on an album featuring the songs "Smiley Faces" and "Crazy" - that album is by *Gnarls Barkley*. For 10 points, name this title received from the Catholic Church after canonization. **Saint**
6. *Name the artist.* "[I]t's gorgeous when you die/Ali recorded and I'm Morpheus, the matrix of my mind". "I'm the biggest hypocrite of 2015/When I finish this if you listening then sure you will agree". "I'm African-American. I'm African. I'm black as the heart of a fuckin' Aryan". "Me and my homies four deep in a white Toyota/A quarter tank of gas, one pistol, and orange soda." "I got, I got, I got, I got/Loyalty, got royalty inside my DNA". For 10 points, "Bitch, sit down./Be Humble". Kendrick **Lamar**
7. *Name the location.* "I am sorry to report/ Dear *this place* is burning after all." - Saint Vincent. "Pray my dick grow get big *as a landmark in this place*/ So I can fuck the world for 72 hours" - Kendrick Lamar. *Instrumental* "April in *this place*" - Ella Fitzgerald and Louis Armstrong. For 10 points, "Doctors say I'm the illest/Cause I'm suffering from

realness./Got my [I'm not allowed to say this word] in this place/ And they goin' gorillas."
- Kanye West from *Watch the Throne*.

8. Name the group. Intro of each song played on guitar - these are fairly recognizable so if it's not figured out quickly go to the next. "I Bet You Look Good on the Dance Floor". "From the Ritz to the Rubble". "R U Mine?". For 10 points, "Do I Wanna Know?". **Arctic Monkeys**
9. Name the group. Intros played on guitar. "Have Love Will Travel". "Everlasting Light". "Little Black Submarines". "Tighten Up". "Gold on the Ceiling". For 10 points, "Lonely Boy". The **Black Keys**
10. This person recently asked on Twitter, "If a bear falls in the woods, does it shit itself?". This person was snubbed from delivering a speech at their high school graduation because they supposedly said "shit" under their breath during the auditions. The author maintains that this person is God. For 10 points, name the author. **David** and/or **Nickel**/the **Author** (before giving it away)
